A gift to Fellowship Afloat

Can be increased...

...if you are a tax payer. We can claim back the income tax you have paid on your donation. This is called a Gift Aid donation, and you'll need to complete a Gift Aid declaration, see the opposite.

At the current basic tax rate of 20%:

- a monthly gift of £10 made by standing order will be increased to £150 per annum.
- a single gift of £100 would be increased to £125.

For every pound you give, the government increases it by 25 pence.

Have you heard of Payroll Giving? This is another way to give tax-effectively to charities. If you pay tax via Pay As You Earn, speak to your payroll department and set up a regular donation to Fellowship Afloat which will then be deducted at source from your pay. The Payroll Giving Agency then pays the sum plus the tax you have paid, directly to us.

To make your gift tax effective...

A declaration must be made by you to Fellowship Afloat that your gift(s) is(are) to be treated as a Gift Aid, and that you pay an amount of income tax or capital gains tax in the relevant tax year that is at least equal to any tax that is reclaimed by all the charities you donate to. We also need to have your name and address.

We'd like to encourage regular committed giving...

...because little-and-often gifts can be easy and add up to a significant donation at the end of the year. And they're good for our planning as we can include regular gifts in our cash flow and be more confident about buying a new boat, taking on seasonal staff or replacing worn out equipment.

The simple banker's order form (opposite) makes a regular gift easy to administer.

For those of you that like to make a small gift when you volunteer...

...this too can be gift-aided; all you need to do is complete the declaration and, when you make a donation during a weekend, make it clear that it's from you and that it is a gift.
